

## 2024 Men's League Rules

Eligibility: Only members of the Potsdam Town \& Country Club who are in good standing may play in the Thursday Men's League. Non-Members can Sub with Pro Shop approval.

Scoring will be based on team net total match play with each hole worth 1 point, allowing a maximum of 9 points for the team match. Strokes will be awarded according to the difference between the team handicap totals with scorecards marked by the Pro Shop to show the teams stroke allotment. With this format, each player has incentive to play well through all nine holes, since all holes won by the team will effect the season accumulative point total.

Individual matches will also be counted and awarded 1 point each, making the nine hole match worth a total of 11 points.

In summary, each nine hole match will basically have 11 chances to win with 2 individual player matches and 9 team matches. Every hole is a new match for the team.

Note - the Eighteen Hole league will be treated as two nine hole matches scored as above for a total of 22 points each week.

League Prizes awarded from the League dues will be similar to past years with some variety as follows:

Low individual Gross and Net
Low Team Gross and Net
Long Drives in 3 age groups
Closest to the pin 8 holes per week
To maintain the integrity of League Prizes for Low Gross or Net, putts over 6" should not be conceded unless for triple bogey or more.

Optional Pro Shop Games of two-man Best Ball or similar will be awarded each week for $\$ 6$ per person. Format may change through the season. Skins will also be available for a $\$ 4$ fee.

## New System for Missed Matches

- At the end of the day each Thursday the scorecards for all the missed matches will be placed, by Division, in wall mounted organizers in the Pro Shop. The players will have access to these cards until the Thursday following the next scheduled match. If at that point the matches have still not been played the cards will be removed and the points will be split between the teams and computed at a reduced rate of 3.5 points per team.
- Matching of scorecards is never permitted for missed matches.
- Should one or both teams lack a sub for a missing member, the remaining player or sub can play the match for the team, counting the score twice.
- If a team is unable to play or make up a scheduled match, the other team shall be awarded 7 points ( 9 -hole league) or 14 points ( 18 -hole league) but only if they play on the originally scheduled day and turn in their scorecard.
- Any disputes will be referred to the Committee for a final decision.
